

**TOWN OF GRANVILLE**  
**SPEED LIMIT ORDINANCE - VT ROUTE 12A**  
**Effective October 3, 2003**

**SECTION 1. AUTHORITY:** This ordinance is adopted by the selectboard of the Town of Granville, Vermont under authority of 23 V.S.A Section 1003 and Section 1007 and 24 V.S.A Section 1972.

**SECTION 2. PURPOSE:** To adopt the Vermont State Traffic Committee's recommendation for the speed limit on Vermont Route 12A through the village of East Granville, Vermont.

**SECTION 3. FINES:**

A violation of this ordinance shall subject the offender to the maximum fine which may be imposed under Section 12 of No. 109 of the Acts of 1989, as may be amended, together with any surcharge imposed under Title 12, V.S.A.

**SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE:**

This ordinance shall become effective 60 days after its adoption by the Town of Granville Selectboard. If a petition is filed under 24 V.S.A Section 1973, that statute shall govern the taking effect of this ordinance.
