

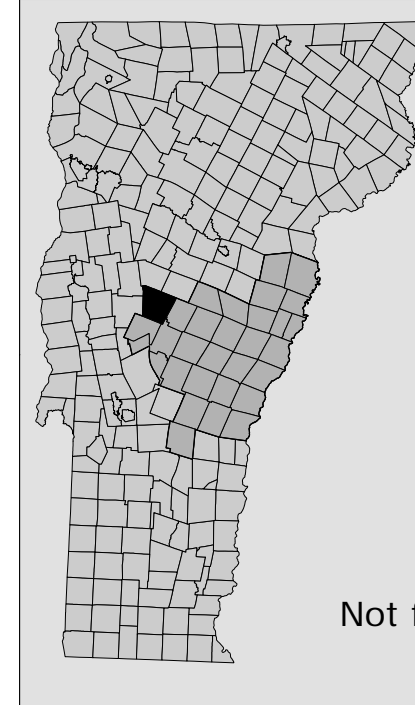

SFHA Zones w/ A 100 year flood delineations refer to areas with a 1 percent ANNUAL chance of flooding.

A The 1-percent-annual-chance flood (or 100-year flood) represents a magnitude and frequency that has a statistical probability of being equaled or exceeded in any given year, or, stated alternatively, the 100-year flood has a 26 percent (or 1 in 4) chance of occurring over the life of a 30-year mortgage.

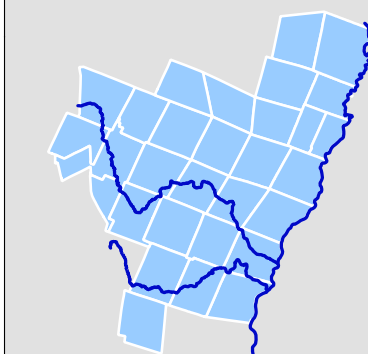


VT State Plane,
