However, if the condition of the property affects me directly, noise, excessive smells, vermin, or is having an environmental impact, hazardous materials, waterway impacts, then I have a complaint as a resident. We cannot access the property as a Select Board member but Mark you can in your official capacity as a Constable in the investigation of formal complaint..

In what limited access I had driving by, it does look like the property owner is pushing debris / material over the embankment behind his trailer and I believe there is a stream that flows down there, I will look at the plot map later today. So Mark, when you get a chance, can you stop by 410 and take a look. Once we have a better idea as to what is going on we can come up with a plan on how to address this issue.
