  - Jim Dages is here - Served on the PC and Selectboard in Granville
- **Agenda Meeting Minutes Review**

- **Granville Town Plan Update Overview**
  - Kyle reviewed the prior grant from the PC in fall 2025

  - Jim is looking for a current copy of the plan (2019)
  - Jim asked how/when the new town plan was adopted?
    - Kyle explained the new plan can be adopted by vote, Australian ballot or by the Selectboard
    - The current plan can be found on the town website, TRORC website, and we can look into a physical copy at town hal
- Conservation Commission was established when floodplain land was given back to the town. Act 250 strengthened the organisation, and the F&G supported it. Conserved land is Granville Commons (west side of road) and Freemans Launch (east side of road). The stream buffer allowed trees to stay intact, and a monument is there honoring those who helped make it happen.
  - Freeman's name came from last owner of land
  - Interest in how the Conservation Commission can be resurrected
- Comments from Jim:
  - Tree buffer was eliminated for a river access area, and more trees were placed
  - Commons has a drilled well for water (but no pump) and a natural spring
  - Bagleys owned the land prior to sale, and they used that for their own water source
  - Common Garden was established, but was not maintained because everyone has their own gardens at home

  - ATV use on Class 4 Roads in Granville... what's allowed?
  - Allowed in Stockbridge (VASA Trails)

  - What role does East Granville play in the Town Plan?
