

TOWN OF GRANVILLE
ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS
FOR GRADING TOWN HIGHWAYS

The Town of Granville is seeking sealed bids for the grading, rolling on the hill sections (when needed) of Town Highways (excluding West Hill Road beyond the US Forest Service gate). Contract begins August 11, 2026 and terminates on December 31, 2029 and all work will be under the supervision of the Road Commissioner. All work must be in compliance with the 2019 State of Vermont Standards for Town Highway Maintenance and Grading Guidelines as adopted by the Granville Selectboard on April 6, 2026.

Bid shall be prepared to show size “hp, weight”, width of mold board and specialty equipment such as scarifier for grader or grader’s with a lump sum bid to grade 16 miles of town highways each year. Include an hourly rate for performing special requests (hills and sections). Proposals shall be received by the Town of Granville at the office of the Town Clerk, 4157 VT Route 100, Granville, Vermont or by e-mail at granvilletown@gmavt.net by August 10, 2026, no later than 4:00 p.m. and clearly marked “Grading Bids”. Then, at said office, bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at its regularly scheduled Selectboard meeting at 6:00 p.m. on August 10, 2026.
