

WINTER ROAD MAINTENANCE SPECIFICATIONS

Town of Granville, Vermont

- Winter road maintenance must be performed on all Class 3 Highways for a total of 16 miles which connect to VT Route 100 (except West Hill Road beyond the gate at the intersection with West Hill Extension) as shown on the official Granville Highway Map. The town highways are Maston Hill, Butz Road, Town Line Road, North Hollow Road, Post Office Hill, Buffalo Farm Road (upper and lower sections), West Hill and West Hill Extension.
- Operate with equipment sufficient to wing roads back efficiently to maintain the clearing width. Width of plowing will be ditch to ditch but no more than 6 inches beyond and will include turnoff areas. At times it may be necessary to clear intersections and blind spots using a loader to push back the snow banks.
- Maston Hill Road is to be kept open as the highest priority to move people.
- In addition to Class 3 Highways, maintenance must be undertaken at: Town Clerk's Office/Town Hall driveway and parking lot which shall be cleared by 6:30 a.m. Monday – Friday and after the storm Friday - Sunday; the front lot and north side of the Fire Station and four (4) dry hydrants (Thomas Hammond's and Stephen Mishkit's on VT Route 100, Rose Delorm's on Post Office Hill and Town Line Road).
- Downed trees are to be removed by the contractor as needed at the same charge as for plowing.
- Road Commissioner will arrange for purchase and delivery of sand to be stockpiled on the south side of the Fire Station. The Contractor will be responsible for piling the sand pile no later than October of each year and will be kept clear of debris.
- Selectboard will hold a pre-winter meeting with contractor and Road Commissioner to discuss procedures and expectations.
- Selectboard and contractor will meet at least once during the winter season to discuss operations and clarify any questions which arise.
- Day-to-day operations of the contractor will be directed by the Road Commissioner.
- Contractor shall carry and maintain all required insurance (general liability, commercial automobile and workmen's compensation) and list the Town of Granville as an additional insured on all policies for this contract. All trucks and equipment used for this contract shall be registered and inspected where applicable, insured and in working condition. All employees shall carry a valid and current Driver's License.

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS WINTER MAINTENANCE OF TOWN HIGHWAYS

The Town of Granville is seeking bids for winter plowing, winging, sanding and other activities in relation to winter maintenance for 16 miles of town highways that connect to VT Route 100.

Bids shall be submitted with lump sum bid and can be different for each year. Bids shall include a description of each piece of equipment and operators experience along with a description of snow removal strategy.

Contract shall begin the first snowfall of 2026 and terminate the last snowfall of 2029.
